

An Overview of the Qualifications and Expectations for a NLBC Board Member

Authority and Responsibility:

The Board of Directors is the legal authority for Ness Lake Bible Camp (NLBC), which is owned by and operated as a ministry point of One Hope Canada (OHC). The Board of Directors act in a position of trust and are responsible for the effective governance of the camp.

Qualifications:

- A believer born again into the family of God through faith in the Lord Jesus Christ, living a life worthy of His calling, active in his/her church.
- Called and committed to serve the mission and goals of NLBC.
- Evidence of potential spiritual leadership.
- Knowledge and skills in one or more areas of Board governance: prayer, policy, projects, finances, fundraising, programs, personnel, advocacy.

Expectations:

- Regular attendance at board meetings. These are normally scheduled monthly (except during July and August).
- To serve on committees as requested by the board.
- Promote and participate in open and healthy discussions at board meetings.
- Represent and promote the camp within the community.
- Consistently act in good faith and in a manner which reflects the best interests of NLBC and the communities it serves.
